

Declaration of Conformity to EU RoHS

Products manufactured by Peter Paul Electronics are in compliance with Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (also known as "RoHS Recast"). In addition, this declaration of conformity is issued under the sole responsibility of Peter Paul Electronics. Specifically, products manufactured do not contain the substances listed in the table below in concentrations greater than the listed maximum limit.

On June 4, 2015, the European Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 added four new substances to the EU RoHS Directive. The restrictions for these additional substances enter into force on July 22, 2019 for all electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) excepting Category 8 and Category 9 products. Category 8 and Category 9 products must comply by July 22, 2021.
